

# HELP NEEDED - PURR RONDY 2008

**Our shows are not possible without your help.** Here are areas where we currently need assistance. Please email [denalicoons@hotmail.com](mailto:denalicoons@hotmail.com) or call Valerie at 269-8828 (day) if you can help.

- **Getting sponsors for the show so we can pay bills due before the show!** See the sponsorship form for details.
- **About 4 able-bodied people to load the equipment Friday before the storage unit closes at 7pm.** The equipment includes the wire cages, tables, table stands, and misc. supplies. Storage unit is at Polar Heated Storage, 1524 E. Dowling Road, Unit D 20, the far end near the school.
- **Reserve, pickup, drive and return a Uhaul or loan us one for the weekend.** Coordinate with those picking up and dropping off the equipment.
- **People to help set up equipment in the show hall** once it makes it to the show hall. The more hands we have available, the sooner we all get to go home that night! If we have enough hands we finish between 9 and 10pm.
- **Coordinate a lunch on Saturday** – We need someone to coordinate the Sunday lunch and a couple people to assist. This will involve pre-ordering the lunch (sandwich fixings, dessert, drinks), setting up the location for lunch, picking-up or putting together the lunch, collecting the monies for lunches sold.
- **Coordinate Sat. night judges dinner at a local restaurant** – We like to have an informal get together over dinner on Saturday night. We need someone to find a restaurant that will take a group of around 20 people and coordinate with the restaurant. We have used the Snow Goose in the past and other locations like Sourdough Mining Co and Sea Galley.
- **Coordinate a lunch on Sunday (pizza run from Costco)** – We need someone to coordinate the Sunday lunch and a couple people to assist. This will involve pre-ordering the pizzas from Costco, setting up the location for lunch, picking-up the pizzas, collecting the monies for lunches sold. At times there have been left-overs from the Saturday lunch that can be sold along with the pizza and some sort of beverage.
- **Distributing flyers about the show to various businesses in town**  
We will have a half page flyer that can be taken to various businesses (pet stores, pet food stores, vet stores, animal loving businesses, etc) for distribution to advertise the show. (Included in this mailing). If you are creative feel free to design a bigger & better flyer!
- **People to help work the gate during the show;** greet visitors, collect donations at the door, and answer some basic questions. If we have enough people willing to help out, we can reduce the time involved.
- **Clerks** – those people who help keep the judges on track and know how to mark a catalog. This can be for a half or full day on Saturday or for Sunday.
- **Master Clerk** – someone to keep the master catalog for the show; preference to licensed master clerks & clerks
- **A new exhibitor helper** - Answer questions for new exhibitors and help them get settled for check in. The primary time for this will be during check-in on Saturday, but may also be on Sunday if we have Sunday only new exhibitors.
- **Drive outside exhibitors to and from the show hall** – This would require you being at the show hall bright and early each day to get your cats settled and then start making trips to the show hotel to help bring our outside/out of town exhibitors to the show hall. Then at the end of the show day, those same people need to go back to the hotel. We usually have no more than 7-8 outside exhibitors so if we have a couple people/cars volunteering, we can get people to the show hall/hotel with just a couple trips.
- **Transport judges and outside exhibitors to the airport after the show.** This transportation is for those who have close connections to the ending time of the show.
- **Pick up 4 bags of ice for the judges' coolers on Saturday and Sunday.**
- **About 4 able-bodied people to load the equipment at the show hall and unload it at the storage unit before 7pm on Sunday.** The equipment includes the wire cages, tables, table stands, and misc. supplies.
